

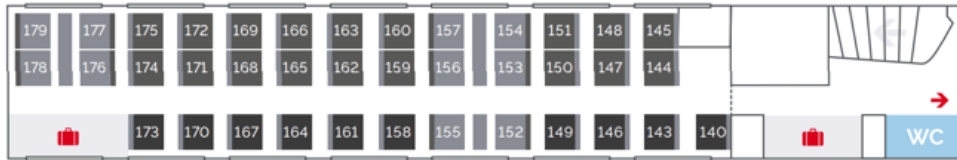
TGV Duplex 2N & Euroduplex seat map

Showing the 3-digit seat numbering which applies from 14 December 22. Cars may be numbered 1-8 on some trains, 11-18 on others.

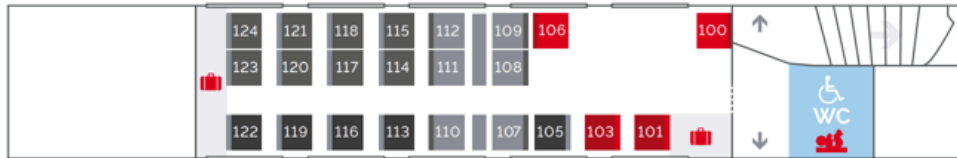
Forward-facing seats? The train can operate in either direction, unfortunately booking systems do not always know which way round the train will be.



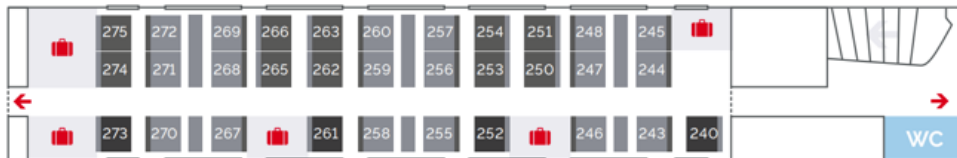

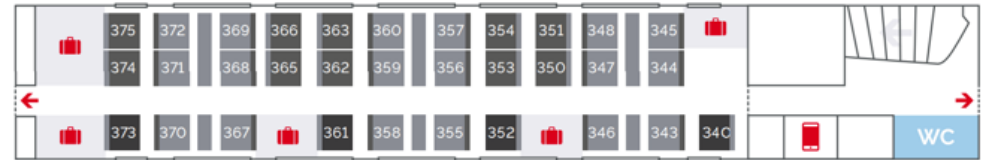

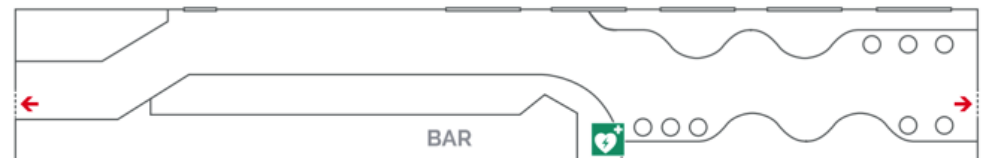

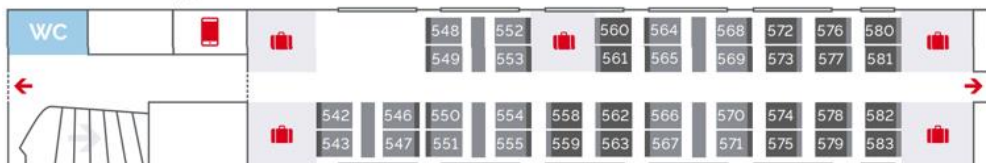

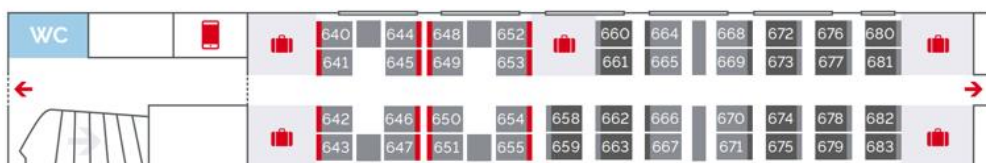

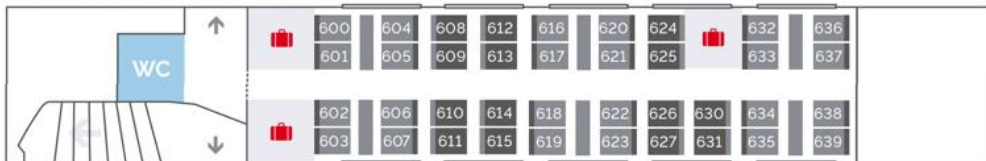

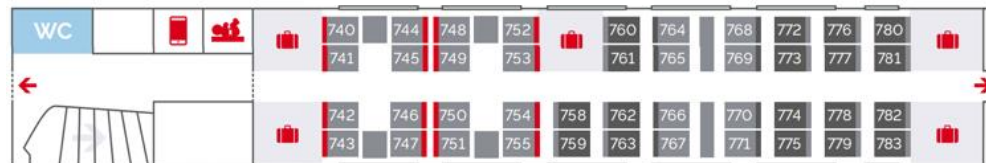

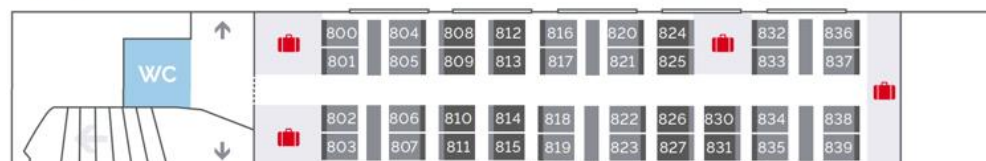
