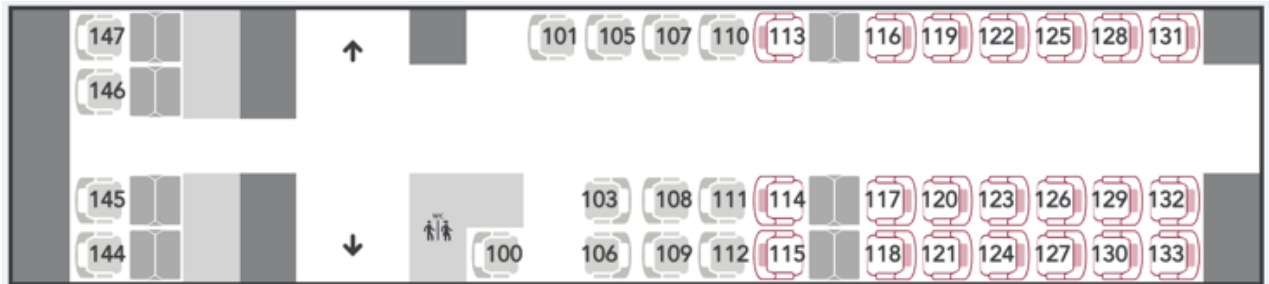


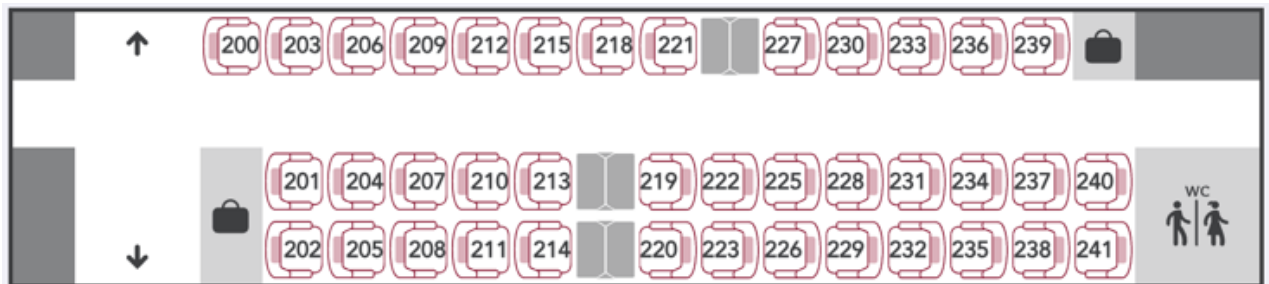
## TGV Réseau

SNCF renumbered all their TGVs with 3-digit numbers from 14 December 2025, where the first digit is the car number 1-8. Direction of travel could be either way. TGV reseau operates Lille-Lyon-Marseille/Montpellier, although it shares the route with some TGV Duplex.

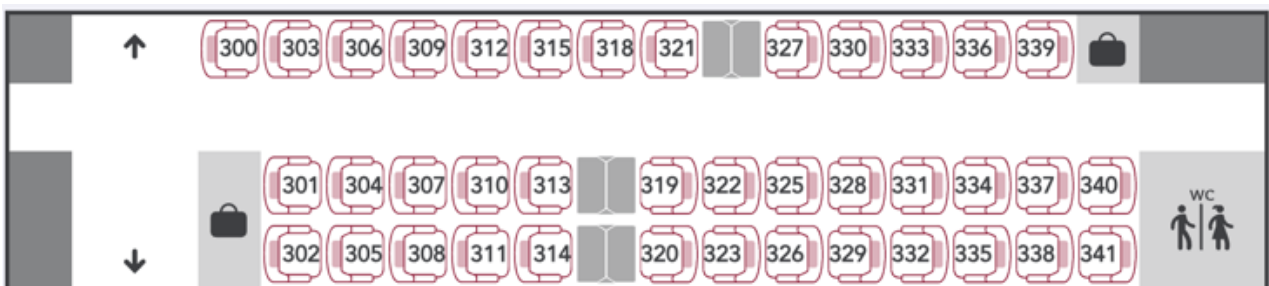
Car 1 or 11



Car 2 or 12

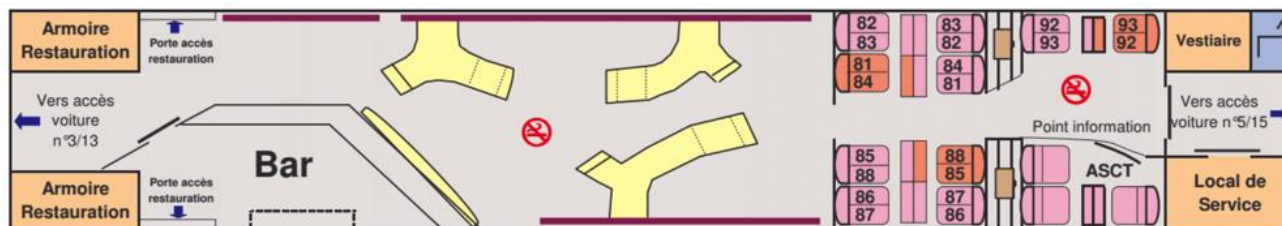


Car 3 or 13

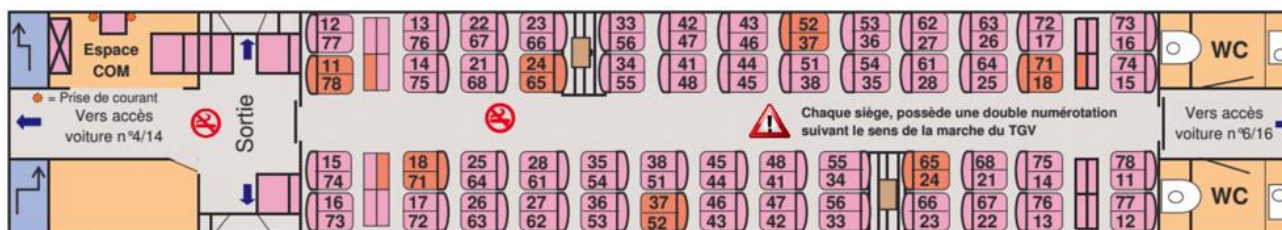

The 2<sup>nd</sup> class seat maps below show the correct seat **layout**, but not the new 3-digit seat **numbering**. Oh, and these units originally had a dual numbering system where the correct number lit up depending on direction of travel, which is why every seat has 2 numbers. Got it? Good!

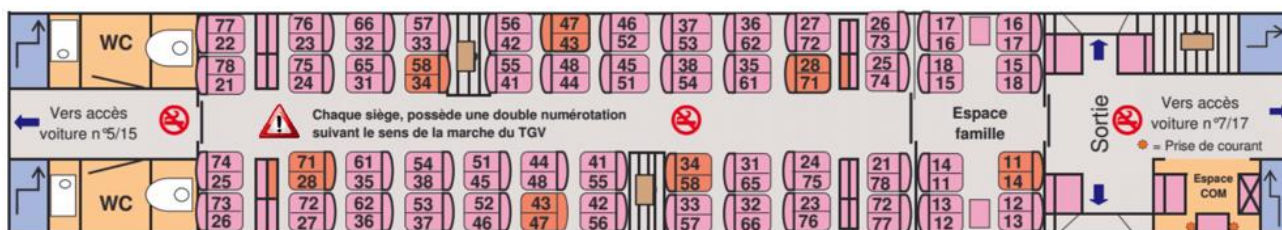
Car 4 (or 14), café-bar
